Concurrent Student Enrollment Form Student Rights & Responsibilities

The Concurrent Student Handbook outlines a student's rights and responsibilities when enrolled as a North Arkansas College concurrent student. The Concurrent Student Handbook is located on the Northark Website at: www.northark.edu/admissions/high-school-students/concurrent-credit.

Only students who are qualified and enrolled in a college concurrent course may attend the course; high school students may not attend the concurrent course to receive only high school credit. North Arkansas College may stipulate additional qualifications for admission to concurrent student status.

- The following enrollment requirements must be met before the student will be enrolled in a concurrent course:
 - Online Application completed
 - Qualifying Test Scores – verified by Northark Admissions
 - Concurrent Enrollment Form completed, signed, and returned to Northark Admissions Office

Once the enrollment process is complete:

- All arrangements of payment of tuition and fees or allowable payment arrangements are the responsibility of the student and must be completed by the posted deadline.
- A concurrently enrolled student will be classified as non-degree seeking.
- Students enrolled concurrently must achieve a 2.00 GPA each semester of Northark enrollment. Students failing to achieve a 2.00 GPA may not re-enroll until they are classified as a degree-seeking student. Exceptions will require the approval of the Executive Vice President of Learning.
- Concurrently enrolled students have all the privileges and responsibilities associated with student status at Northark.
 - Includes full access to Northark's library, academic and career advising, and tutoring opportunities.
- Concurrent students who must drop a course they are enrolled in will be required to complete the withdrawal process through Northark Enrollment Services.
