

Dear Allied Health Student

The Hepatitis B Vaccination is offered through North Arkansas Regional Medical Center's (NARMC) Employee Health Office to all students currently accepted into an Allied Health program, i.e. Nursing, EMS, Med. Tech., Rad. Tech., CNA, Surg. Tech., etc. Contact the Employee Health Office to set up an appointment to start the vaccine series.

The vaccine is provided at cost. The student is responsible for paying for each dose of the vaccine before it is administered.

The student must pre-pay for the vaccine, at the cashier's office, prior to coming to the Employee Health Office. The cost of the total vaccine series is \$75, payable in \$25 increments with each vaccination, for a total of three. The **only** exception is students who are receiving assistance from WIA.

The Hepatitis B Vaccine will be started if:

1. The student has provided a letter of acceptance to an Allied Health Program.
 2. The student has provided a paid receipt for the vaccination, paid at the hospital cashier's office.
- or
- A WIA representative has notified the Employee Health Office, prior to the vaccinations being given, that the student is receiving WIA assistance.
